To develop and deliver the Server Administration course (ITDI201), including the preparation of course materials and teaching of lectures and laboratory sessions.

Position Summary

The position is responsible for the development and delivery of the Server Administration course (ITDI201) and will work closely with the ICT Diploma Coordinator, ICT Program Advisor, and other ICT Diploma course developers and lecturers. In addition, the role involves engaging with industry partners to create learning opportunities and facilitating programming – specific internship programs.
